Genesis 31:1-2 NLT

And Jacob began to notice <u>a change in Laban's attitude</u> toward him.

Signs of a bad attitude

✓ Grumbling & Murmuring

Genesis 31:1a NLT

Jacob soon learned that Laban's sons were grumbling about him.

✓ Assumptions & Accusations

Genesis 31:1b NLT

"Jacob has robbed our father of everything!" they said.

"He has gained his wealth at our father's expense."

✓ <u>Unkind</u> Treatment

Genesis 31:2 NLT

And Jacob began to notice a change in Laban's attitude toward him.

Overcoming Bad Attitudes

2 Corinthians 10:3-5 Message

- 3 The world is unprincipled. It's dog-eat-dog out there! The world doesn't fight fair. But we don't live or fight our battles that way never have and never will.
- 4 The tools of our trade aren't for marketing or manipulation, but they are for demolishing that entire massively corrupt culture. 5 <u>We use our powerful God-tools for</u> smashing warped philosophies, tearing down barriers erected against the truth of God, fitting every loose <u>thought</u> and <u>emotion</u> and <u>impulse</u> into the structure of life shaped by Christ.

To Change Attitudes

Authority over a bad attitudes...

1. Put yourself in a place to hear direction from the Lord.

Genesis 31:3 NKJV

Then **the Lord said to Jacob**,

"Return to the land of your fathers and to your family, and I will be with you."

Matthew 6:33 NKJV

But seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you.

2. Be <u>agreeable</u> and <u>pray</u> for those who hurt you.

Genesis 31:44 NCV

Let us make an agreement, and let us set up a pile of stones to remind us of it.

Luke 6:27-28 NLT

27 "But to you who are willing to listen,

I say, <u>love</u> your enemies! <u>Do good</u> to those who hate you. 28 Bless those who curse you. Pray for those who hurt you.

3. Live out your God created identity.

Genesis 32:28 NKJV And He said,

"Your name shall no longer be called Jacob, but Israel;

for you have struggled with God and with men, and have prevailed."

Matthew 5:48 Message

Now live like it. *Live out your God-created identity*.

Live generously and graciously toward others, the way God lives toward you.
