✓ God gives you everything you need to share your testimony.

2 Timothy 1:7-8 NKJV

7 For God has not given us a spirit of fear, but of <u>power</u> and of <u>love</u> and of a <u>sound mind</u>. 8 Therefore **do not be ashamed of the testimony of our Lord**...

To Speak

Authority to Speak ...

1. Your testimony to bring unity.

Romans 15:5-6 NIV

5 May the God who gives endurance and encouragement *give you a spirit of unity* among yourselves as you follow Christ Jesus, 6 so that *with one heart* and *mouth you may glorify the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ*.

2. Your testimony to help people remember God's goodness.

Deuteronomy 4:9 NLT

"But watch out! <u>Be careful never to forget what you yourself have seen.</u>

<u>Do not let these memories escape from your mind as long as you live!</u>

And be sure to <u>pass them on to your children and grandchildren.</u>

3. Your testimony as a weapon.

Revelation 12:11 NKJV

And they overcame him (satan) by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony, and they did not love their lives to the death.

4. Your testimony proclaims that God can do it again.

1 Samuel 17:37 NLT

The Lord who rescued me from the <u>claws of the lion and the bear</u> will rescue me from this Philistine!"
