1. Sacrifice now...to become the person you dream.

Genesis 39:12-23 CEV

12 Potiphar's wife grabbed hold of his coat and said,

"Make love to me!" Joseph ran out of the house, leaving her hanging onto his coat.

19 Potiphar became very angry 20 and threw Joseph in the same prison where the king's prisoners were kept. While Joseph was in prison, 21 the Lord helped him and was good to him. He even made the jailer like Joseph so much that 22 he put him in charge of the other prisoners and of everything that was done in the jail. 23 The jailer did not worry about anything, because the Lord was with Joseph and made him successful in all that he did.
