## The cost of doing right...

2 Chronicles 19:11-20:3

11 Take courage as you fulfill your duties,

### and may the Lord be with those who do what is right."

20 After this, the armies of the Moabites, Ammonites, and some of the Meunites declared war on Jehoshaphat. 2 Messengers came and told Jehoshaphat, "A vast army from Edom is marching against you from beyond the Dead Sea. They are already at Hazazon-tamar."

(This was another name for En-gedi.)

3 Jehoshaphat was terrified by this news and begged the Lord for guidance. He also ordered everyone in Judah to begin fasting.

## The Backlash of Bad News...

✓ <u>Fear</u>.

### Isaiah 35:4 NLT

*Say to those with fearful hearts*, "Be strong, and do not fear, for your God is coming to destroy your enemies. He is coming to save you."

### ✓ Discouragement.

John 16:33 NASU

In the world you have tribulation but *take courage*; I have overcome the world.

### ✓ Fight your battles alone.

### John 14:15-16 NLT

15 "If you love Me, obey My commandments. 16 And I will ask the Father, and He will give you another Advocate, who *will never leave you*.

### ✓ <u>Unbelief</u>.

### Mark 1:15

"The time promised by God has come at last!" He announced. "The Kingdom of God is near! **Repent of your sins and <u>believe the Good News</u>!"**

# Marching to your Breakthrough...

# 1. Pray Fast

✓ Ask

2 Chronicles 20:4 אאזע So Judah gathered together to <u>ask help from the Lord</u>;

### ✓ Admit & Acknowledge.

2 Chronicles 20:12 NLT

O our God, won't you stop them? <u>We are powerless</u> against this mighty army that is about to attack us. <u>We do not know what to do</u>, but we are looking to You for help."

# 2. <u>Presence</u>

### 2 Chronicles 20:9 NLT

They said, 'Whenever we are faced with any calamity such as war, plague, or famine, we can come to <u>stand in Your presence</u> before this Temple where Your name is honored. We can cry out to You to save us, and You will hear us and rescue us.'

### 2 Chronicles 20:14-15 NKJV

14 Then <u>the Spirit of the Lord came upon Jahaziel</u>...in the midst of the assembly.
15 And he said, "Listen, all you of Judah and you inhabitants of Jerusalem, and you, King Jehoshaphat! Thus says the Lord to you: <u>'Do not be afraid nor dismayed</u> because of this great multitude, for the battle is not yours, but God's.

# 3. <u>Position</u> of Praise

### 2 Chronicles 20:17 NKJV

You will not need to fight in this battle. <u>Position yourselves</u>, stand still and see the salvation of the Lord, who is with you, O Judah and Jerusalem!'

Do not fear or be dismayed; tomorrow go out against them, for the Lord is with you."

### 2 Chronicles 20:20-21 NLT

20... Believe in the Lord your God, and you will be able to stand firm.

Believe in His prophets, and you will succeed."

21 After consulting the people, *the king appointed singers to walk ahead of the army,* <u>singing to the Lord and praising Him</u> for His holy splendor. This is what they sang:

"Give thanks to the Lord; His faithful love endures forever!"
