Acts 2:42-47 NLT

How to Alternate Power with each other...

1. Help and serve each other.

John 13:12-16 NLT

12 After washing their feet, He put on His robe again and sat down and asked, "Do you understand what I was doing? 13 You call Me 'Teacher' and 'Lord,' and you are right, because that's what I am. 14 And since I, your Lord and Teacher, have washed your feet, you ought to **wash each other's feet.**
15 **I have given you an example to follow. Do as I have done to you.**

Ecclesiastes 4:9-10 NLT

9 **Two people are better off than one, for they can help each other succeed.**

10 If one person falls, the other can reach out and help.

But someone who falls alone is in real trouble.

2. Encourage each other.

John 14:1 NKJV

Let not your heart be troubled; you believe in God, believe also in Me.

Hebrews 3:13 NIV

But **encourage one another** daily, as long as it is called Today, **so that none of you may be hardened by sin's deceitfulness.**

3. Remain connected to Jesus and each other.

John 15:4-6 NKJV

4 Remain in Me, and I will remain in you. **For a branch cannot produce fruit if it is severed from the vine, and you cannot be fruitful unless you remain in Me.**

5 "Yes, I am the vine; you are the branches. **Those who remain in Me, and I in them, will produce much fruit.** For **apart from Me you can do nothing.**

4. Guard each other.

John 16:1 NKJV

These things I have spoken to you, that **you should not be made to stumble.**

Ecclesiastes 4:12 NLT

A person standing alone can be attacked and defeated,
but **two can stand back-to-back and conquer.**

Three are even better, for a triple-braided cord is not easily broken.

5. Pray for each other.

John 17:1 & 9 NIV

1 After Jesus said this, He looked toward heaven and prayed:

"Father, the time has come. Glorify your Son, that your Son may glorify You.

9 I pray for them. I am not praying for the world,
but for those you have given Me, for they are Yours.
