His clothes became shining white. 30 Then two men were there, talking with Him. They were Moses and Elijah. 31 They also looked bright and glorious. They were talking with Jesus about His death that would happen in Jerusalem. 32 Peter and the others were asleep. But they woke up and saw the glory of Jesus.

32...But they woke up and saw the glory of Jesus.
