Communication is the key to resolving conflict... but the secret to connecting with people is finding common ground.

God has saved you for relationships!

1 Corinthians 9:22-23 TLB

22 When I am with those whose consciences bother them easily, I don't act as though I know it all and don't say they are foolish; the result is that they are willing to let me help them. Yes, whatever a person is like, <u>I try to find common ground with him</u> so that he will let me tell him about Christ and let Christ save him. 23 I do this to get the Gospel to them and also for the blessing I myself receive when I see them come to Christ.

Obstacles to finding common ground...

<u>Assumption</u>: "I <u>already know</u> what other people are like."

Proverbs 3:7 Message <u>Don't assume</u> that you know it all. Run to God! Run from evil!

- ✓ <u>Conceit</u>: "I don't <u>need</u> to know other people."
- ✓ <u>Apathy</u>: "I don't <u>care</u> to know other people."
- ✓ <u>Concealment</u>: "I don't want other people to <u>know the real me</u>."

Connect by finding common ground.

1. Make yourself available to others.

Matthew 8:16 GNT

When evening came, <u>people brought to Jesus</u> many who had demons in them. Jesus drove out the evil spirits with a word and healed all who were sick.

2. <u>Listen</u> to hear the heart of others.

Luke 12:34 CEV

Your heart will always be where your treasure is.

3. Be open by letting people into your life.

Matthew 17:1-2, 7-8 NLT

1 Six days later Jesus took Peter and the two brothers, James and John, and led them up a high mountain to be alone. 2 As the men watched, Jesus' appearance was transformed so

that His face shone like the sun, and His clothes became as white as light.
7 Then Jesus came over and touched them. "Get up," He said. "Don't be afraid."
8 And when they looked, *they saw only Jesus*.

James 5:16 NLT

Confess your sins to each other and pray for each other so that you may be healed....

4. Be sincerely *interested* in the lives of others.

Philippians 2:3-5 NCV

3 When you do things, do not let selfishness or pride be your guide. Instead, *be humble* and give more honor to others than to yourselves.

Do not be interested only in your own life, but <u>be interested in the lives of others.</u>

5 In your lives you must think and act like Christ Jesus.
