✓ Why did Jesus come...

Luke 19:10 NLT

For the **Son of Man came to seek and save those who are lost.**

✓ How did Jesus come...

Luke 7:34 NKJV

The **Son of Man has come eating and drinking,** and you say, 'Look, a glutton and a winebibber, a friend of tax collectors and sinners!'

✓ Are you like Jesus?

1 Corinthians 9:22-23 TLB

22 When I am with those whose consciences bother them easily, I don't act as though I know it all and don't say they are foolish; the result is that they are willing to let me help them. Yes, whatever a person is like, **I try to find common ground** with him so that he will let me tell him about Christ and let Christ save him. 23 I do this to get the Gospel to them and also for the blessing I myself receive when I see them come to Christ.

Fellowship in the Greek is koinonia: communion, sharing in common.

The Power of Fellowship

Dining Like Jesus...

1. Fellowship develops **relationships.**

Luke 5:29-32 NLT

29 Later, **Levi held a banquet in his home with Jesus as the guest of honor.** Many of Levi's fellow tax collectors and other guests also ate with them. 30 But the Pharisees and their teachers of religious law complained bitterly to Jesus' disciples, "Why do you eat and drink with such scum?"

31 Jesus answered them, **Healthy people don't need a doctor—sick people do. 32 I have come to call** not those who think they are righteous, but those who know they are sinners and need to repent."

✓ Establish a **relationship** with Levi. (Love People)

✓ **Evangelize** Levi's circle of friends. (Love God)

2. Fellowship makes room for **more.**

Acts 2:42-47 NLT

. 46 They worshiped together at the Temple each day, **met in homes for the Lord's Supper,** and **shared their meals** with great joy and generosity— 47 all the while praising God and enjoying the goodwill of all the people. And each day **the Lord added to their fellowship those who were being saved.**

3. Fellowship keeps us focused on the **KING.**

Matthew 26:26-29 NASU

26 While they were eating, Jesus took some bread, and after a blessing, He broke it and gave it to the disciples, and said, **"Take, eat; this is My body."** 27 And when He had taken a cup and given thanks, He gave it to them, saying, **"Drink from it, all of you; 28 for this is My blood of the covenant,** which is poured out for many for forgiveness of sins. 29 "But I say to you, I will not drink of this fruit of the vine from now on until that day when I drink it new with you in My Father's kingdom."
