Luke 24:1-12 NLT

1 But very early on Sunday morning the women went to the tomb, taking the spices they had prepared. 2 They found that the stone had been rolled away from the entrance. 3 So they went in, but they didn't find the body of the Lord Jesus. 4 As they stood there puzzled, two men suddenly appeared to them, clothed in dazzling robes. 5 The women were terrified and bowed with their faces to the ground. Then the men asked, "Why are you looking among the dead for someone who is alive?" 6 He isn't here! He is risen from the dead! Remember what He told you back in Galilee, 7 that the Son of Man must be betrayed into the hands of sinful men and be crucified, and that He would rise again on the third day." 8 Then they remembered that He had said this. 9 So they rushed back from the tomb to tell His eleven disciples—and everyone else—what had happened. 10 It was Mary Magdalene, Joanna, Mary the mother of James, and several other women who told the apostles what had happened. 11 But the story sounded like nonsense to the men, so they didn't believe it.

Good News

1. Jesus is the Son of God.

Mark 2:5-7 NLT

5 Seeing their faith, Jesus said to the paralyzed man, "My child, your sins are forgiven."
 6 But some of the teachers of religious law who were sitting there thought to themselves,
 7 "What is he saying? This is blasphemy! Only God can forgive sins!"

Mark 2:28 NKJV

"Therefore the Son of Man is also Lord of the Sabbath."

John 8:58 NKJV

Jesus said to them, "Most assuredly, I say to you, before Abraham was, I AM."

Romans 1:3-4 NLT

3 The Good News is about His Son, Jesus. In His earthly life He was born into King David's family line, 4 and He was shown to be the Son of God when He was raised from the dead by the power of the Holy Spirit. He is Jesus Christ our Lord.

2. Jesus died by crucifixion to save you.

Colossians 2:13-14 NLT

13 You were dead because of your sins and because your sinful nature was not yet cut away. Then God made you alive with Christ, for He forgave all our sins.
 14 He canceled the record of the charges against us and took it away by nailing it to the cross.

1 Peter 1:7 NLT

He personally carried our sins in His body on the cross
 so that we can be dead to sin and live for what is right.
By His wounds you are healed.

3. Jesus rose from the dead to give you life!
