- ✓ Jesus appears to the other **Women**. Matthew 28:9-10
- ✓ Jesus appears to the Disciples **walking**. Luke 24:13-35, Mark 16:12
- ✓ Jesus appears to **Peter**. Luke 24:34, 1 Corinthians 15:5
- ✓ Jesus appears to the Disciples. Luke 24:36-43, John 20:19-23
- ✓ Jesus appears to the Disciples (with Thomas). John 20:26-29
- ✓ Jesus appears to Disciples while they are **fishing**. John 21:1-14
- ✓ Jesus appears to over 500 Disciples at once. 1 Corinthians 15:6
- ✓ Jesus appears to the 11 Disciples in Galilee. Matthew 28:16-20
- ✓ Jesus appears to **Disciples** on Mt. of Olives. Luke 24:50-53, Acts 1:3-11

40 Days of Purpose

40 Days of Purpose

1. **REVELATION** - Let the Scriptures speak to you.

Luke 24:25-27 CEV

25 Then Jesus asked the two disciples,
"Why can't you understand? How can you be so slow to believe all that the prophets said?
26 Didn't you know that the Messiah would have to suffer before He was given His glory?"

27 Jesus then explained everything written about Himself in the Scriptures,

beginning with the Law of Moses and the Books of the Prophets.

Luke 24:44-45 NLT

44 Then He said, "When I was with you before,
I told you that everything written about Me
in the law of Moses and the prophets and in the Psalms must be fulfilled."

45 Then He opened their minds to understand the Scriptures.

2. **RELATIONSHIP** – Reach out to Jesus for closeness.

John 20:26-29 NIV

26 A week later His disciples were in the house again, and Thomas was with them.
Though the doors were locked, Jesus came and stood among them and said,
"Peace be with you!" 27 Then He said to Thomas, "Put your finger here; see My hands.
Reach out your hand and put it into My side. Stop doubting and believe."

28 Thomas said to him, "My Lord and my God!"

29 Then Jesus told him, "Because you have seen Me, you have believed; blessed are those who have not seen and yet have believed."

Luke 24:32 NLT

They said to each other, "Didn't our hearts burn within us as He talked with us on the road and explained the Scriptures to us?"

3. **RESTORATION** – Allow Jesus to restore your identity in Him.

John 21:17 NLT

A third time He asked him, "Simon son of John, do you love Me?"

Peter was hurt that Jesus asked the question a third time.

He said, "Lord, you know everything. You know that I love you."

Jesus said, "Then feed My sheep."
