Revelation 1:10-19 NKJV

10 I was in the Spirit on the Lord's Day, and I heard behind me a loud voice, as of a trumpet, 11 saying, "I am the Alpha and the Omega, the First and the Last,"...

12 Then I turned to see the voice that spoke with me. And having turned I saw seven golden lampstands, 13 and in the midst of the seven lampstands One like the Son of Man, clothed with a garment down to the feet and girded about the chest with a golden band.

14 His head and hair were white like wool, as white as snow, and His eyes like a flame of fire; 15 His feet were like fine brass, as if refined in a furnace, and His voice as the sound of many waters; 16 He had in His right hand seven stars, out of His mouth went a sharp two-edged sword, and His countenance was like the sun shining in its strength. 17 And when I saw Him, I fell at His feet as dead. But He laid His right hand on me, saying to me

✓ <u>Happiness</u> is dead.

Lamentations 3:17 NCV

I have no more peace. I have forgotten what happiness is.

✓ Heart's desire is dead.

Proverbs 13:12 ESV

Hope deferred makes the heart sick, but a desire fulfilled is a tree of life.

✓ Hope is dead.

Lamentations 3:18 NCV

I said, "My strength is gone, and *I have no hope* in the Lord."

Keys for a Resurrection Miracle

Revelation 10:18 NKJV

I am He who lives, and was dead, and behold, I am alive forevermore. Amen.

And I have the keys of Hades and of Death.

1. Visit the place where you buried your hopes and dreams.

Matthew 28:1 NLT

Early on Sunday morning, as <u>the new day was dawning</u>, Mary Magdalene and the other Mary went out to <u>visit the tomb</u>.

2. Look for the risen Jesus.

Matthew 28:5-6 NLT

5 Then the angel spoke to the women. "Don't be afraid!" he said.

"I know you are looking for Jesus, who was crucified. 6 He isn't here!

<u>He is risen from the dead</u>, just as He said would happen.

Come, see where His body was lying.

3. Go to meet with the Lord.

Matthew 28:8-10 NLT

8 The women ran quickly from the tomb.

They were very frightened but also filled with great joy, and they rushed to give the disciples the angel's message. 9 And *as they went, Jesus met them and greeted them.*

And they ran to Him, grasped His feet, and worshiped Him.

10 Then Jesus said to them, "Don't be afraid!

Go tell My brothers to leave for Galilee, and they will see Me there."

4. **Believe** a resurrection miracle is for you.

Romans 8:10-11 Message

10 But *for you who welcome Him*, in whom He dwells — even though you still experience all the limitations of sin — you yourself experience life on God's terms.

11 It stands to reason, doesn't it, that if the alive-and-present God who raised Jesus from the dead moves into your life, He'll do the same thing in you that He did in Jesus,

bringing you alive to Himself? When God lives and breathes in you (and He does, as surely as He did in Jesus), you are delivered from that dead life.

With His Spirit living in you, your body will be as alive as Christ's!
