Discover The One Thing

Luke 10:42 NLT

There is <u>only one thing</u> worth being concerned about.

Mary has discovered it, and it will not be taken away from her.

1. Live a balanced life.

Luke 10:39-40 NLT

39 Her sister, *Mary, sat at the Lord's feet, listening to what he taught*.
40 But Martha was distracted by *the big dinner she was preparing*.

2. Take it to the Lord...and take personal responsibility.

Luke 10:40 NLT

But Martha was distracted by the big dinner she was preparing.

She came to Jesus and said, "Lord, doesn't it seem unfair to you that my sister just sits here while I do all the work? Tell her to come and help me."

3. You are only as close to God as you choose to be.

Luke 10:42 NKJV

But one thing is needed, and *Mary has <u>chosen</u> that good part*, which will not be taken away from her.

4. There is <u>life</u> in relationships...the rest is just details.
