Acts 2:1-4 NIV

2 Suddenly a sound like the blowing of a violent wind came from heaven and filled the whole house where they were sitting. 3 They saw what seemed to be tongues of fire that separated and came to rest on each of them. 4 All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other tongues as the Spirit enabled them.

Acts 1:4-5 NLT

4 Once when He was eating with them, He commanded them, "<u>Do not leave Jerusalem</u> <u>until the Father sends you the gift He promised</u>, as I told you before. 5 John baptized with water, but in just a few days you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit."

✓ The Wind and Fire.

Matthew 3:11 NIV

"I baptize you with water for repentance.

But after me will come one who is more powerful than I, whose sandals I am not fit to carry. *He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and with fire.*

Acts 2:11 NLT

we all hear <u>these people speaking in our own languages</u> about the wonderful things God has done!"

After the Delivery

1. Focus upward on Jesus.

John 16:13-14 NLT

13 When the Spirit of truth comes, He will guide you into all truth. He will not speak on His own but will tell you what He has heard. He will tell you about the future.

14 He will bring Me glory by telling you whatever He receives from Me.

- ✓ His <u>Humanity</u>: "God publicly endorsed <u>Jesus the Nazarene"</u> (Acts 2:22)
- ✓ His Death: "you nailed Him to a cross and killed Him." (Acts 2:23)
- ✓ His Resurrection: "God raised Jesus from the dead," (Acts 2:32)
- **✓** His <u>Exaltation</u>: "<u>He is exalted to the place of highest honor in heaven</u>..." (Acts 2:33)
- His Forgiveness: "Repent and be baptized...in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins." (Acts 2:38)

2. Fire up to live a new life of worship.

1 Peter 2:4-NI

5 <u>you also, like living stones, are being built into a spiritual house</u> to be a holy priesthood, offering spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ.

Romans 12:1 NLT

And so, dear brothers and sisters,

I plead with you to give your bodies to God because of all He has done for you.

Let them *be a living and holy sacrifice*—the kind He will find acceptable.

This is truly the way to worship Him.

3. Fill up for the mission.

Then <u>Peter, filled with the Holy Spirit</u>, said to them, (Acts 4:7-11) <u>all filled with the Holy Spirit</u>, and they spoke the word of God with boldness. (Acts 4:31)

Ephesians 5:18-20 NLT

18 Don't be drunk with wine, because that will ruin your life.

Instead, **be filled with the Holy Spirit**, 19 singing psalms and hymns and spiritual songs among yourselves, and making music to the Lord in your hearts.

20 And give thanks for everything to God the Father in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ.
