Acts 2:1-4 TLB

✓ **I**solation

Acts 2:1 NIV When the day of Pentecost came, <u>they were all together in one place.</u>

✓ Indecision

Luke 24:49 NLT I will send the Holy Spirit, just as My Father promised.



John 21:23 CEV

Don't leave Jerusalem yet. Wait here for the Father to give you the Holy Spirit,

✓ <u>I</u>gnorance

Luke 3:16 NKJV

John answered, saying to all,

"I indeed baptize you with water; but One mightier than I is coming, whose sandal strap I am not worthy to loose. <u>He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and fire.</u>"

Expecting Help

What to expect...

1. Expect the Holy Spirit to MOVE you.

Hebrews 12:18, 22-24 NLT

18 You have not come to a physical mountain, to a place of flaming fire, darkness, gloom, and whirlwind, as the Israelites did at Mount Sinai...22 No, you have come to Mount Zion, to the city of the living God, the heavenly Jerusalem, and to countless thousands of angels

in a joyful gathering. 23 You have come to the assembly of God's firstborn children, whose names are written in heaven. You have come to God Himself, who is the judge over all things. You have come to the spirits of the righteous ones in heaven who have now been made perfect. 24 You have come to Jesus, the one who mediates the new covenant between God and people, and to the sprinkled blood, which speaks of forgiveness instead of crying out for vengeance like the blood of Abel.

2. Expect the MANIFESTATION of the Holy Spirit.

1 Corinthians 12:7-11 NKJV

7 But the manifestation of the Spirit is given to each one for the profit of all:

8 for to one is given the word of wisdom through the Spirit, to another the word of knowledge through the same Spirit, 9 to another faith by the same Spirit, to another gifts of healings by the same Spirit, 10 to another the working of miracles, to another prophecy, to another discerning of spirits, to another different kinds of tongues, to another the interpretation of tongues. 11 But one and the same Spirit works all these things, distributing to each one individually as He wills.

Galatians 5:22-23 NKJV

22 But <u>the fruit of the Spirit</u> is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, 23 gentleness, self-control. Against such there is no law.

3. Expect the MESSAGE of the Holy Spirit.

Acts 2:38-39 NKJV

38 Then Peter said to them, "Repent, and let every one of you be baptized in the name of

Jesus Christ for the remission of sins; and you shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.

39 For the promise is to you and to your children, and to all who are afar off, as many as the Lord our God will call."
