Jesus Introduces A Real Friend

John 14:15-17 NLT

15 "If you love me, obey my commandments. 16 And I will ask the Father, and he will give you *another <u>Advocate</u>, who will never leave you*. 17 He is the Holy Spirit, who leads into all truth. The world cannot receive him, because it isn't looking for him and doesn't

recognize him. But you know him, because he lives with you now and later will be in you.

Advocate: One who pleads for another, defends, vindicates, a real friend.

Levels of Friendship

 ✓ Acquaintance: Known through someone else, superficial. Matthew 7:21-23 NLT

22 On judgment day many will say to me, 'Lord! Lord! We prophesied in your name and cast out demons in your name and performed many miracles in your name.'
23 But I will reply, <u>'I never knew you</u>. Get away from me, you who break God's laws.'

✓ Casual Friends: People you may know on a first name basis.

Psalm 9:10 NKJV And those who know Your name will put their trust in You; For You, *Lord, have not forsaken those who seek You*.

✓ Close Friends: Mutual agreement on the issues of life.

Galatians 5:24-25 NIV

24 Those who belong to Christ Jesus have crucified the sinful nature with its passions and desires. 25 Since we live by the Spirit, *let us keep in step with the Spirit*.

✓ Intimate Friends: Share your heart, invested in one another.

1. Share your heart with Him.

3. Ask Him to <u>fill</u> your heart.

Ephesians 5:18-19 NLT

18 Don't be drunk with wine, because that will ruin your life.

Instead, *be filled with the Holy Spirit*, 19 singing psalms and hymns and spiritual songs among yourselves and *making music to the Lord in your hearts*.
