Building Blocks of Freedom...

1. FREEDOM to **first build in the right priorities!**

1 Kings 17:13 NLT

But Elijah said to her, "Don't be afraid! Go ahead and do just what you've said, but **make a little bread for me first.** Then use what's left to prepare a meal for yourself and your son.

Matthew 6:33 NASU

But **seek first His kingdom and His righteousness,** and all these things will be added to you

2. FREEDOM to **grow beyond your limits.**

2 Kings 4:2-6 NIV

2 Elisha replied to her, "How can I help you? Tell me, what do you have in your house?"
"Your servant has nothing there at all," she said, "except a little oil."

3 Elisha said, "**Go around and ask all your neighbors for empty jars.** Don't ask for just a few. 4 Then go inside and shut the door behind you and your sons. Pour oil into all the jars, and as each is filled, put it to one side." 5 She left him and afterward shut the door behind her and her sons. They brought the jars to her and she kept pouring.

6 When all the jars were full, she said to her son, "Bring me another one." But he replied, "There is not a jar left." Then the oil stopped flowing.

3. FREEDOM to make **room for God's favor.**

2 Kings 4:10 NLT

Let's build a small room for him on the roof and furnish it with a bed, a table, a chair, and a lamp. Then he will have a place to stay whenever he comes by."

Isaiah 54:2-3 NLT

2 "**Enlarge** your house; **build** an addition. **Spread out** your home, and **spare no expense!** 3 For you will soon be bursting at the seams. Your descendants will occupy other nations and resettle the ruined cities.
