1 Corinthians 9:22-23 TLB



1. Come and <u>see</u>.

John 1:39 NLT

"<u>Come and see</u>," he said. It was about four o'clock in the afternoon when they went with him to the place where he was staying, and they remained with him the rest of the day.

John 1:40-42 NLT

40 Andrew, Simon Peter's brother, was one of these men who heard what John said and then followed Jesus. 41 *Andrew went to find his brother*, Simon, and told him, "We have found the Messiah" (which means "Christ"). 42 Then *Andrew brought Simon to meet Jesus*.

2. Come and <u>follow</u>.

John 1:43-46 NLT

43 The next day Jesus decided to go to Galilee. He found Philip and said to him,
"<u>Come, follow Me.</u>" 44 Philip was from Bethsaida, Andrew and Peter's hometown.
45 Philip went to look for Nathanael and told him, "We have found the very person Moses and the prophets wrote about! His name is Jesus, the son of Joseph from Nazareth." 46 "Nazareth!" exclaimed Nathanael. "Can anything good come from Nazareth?" "Come and see for yourself," Philip replied.

3. Come and <u>believe</u> Jesus and see heaven open.

John 1:50 PHILLIPS

<u>Believe me</u>," he added, "I tell you all that you will see Heaven wide open and God's angels ascending and descending around the Son of Man!"
