A Good Mystery...

Ephesians 3:1-4 NLT

1 When I think of all this, I, Paul, a prisoner of Christ Jesus for the benefit of you Gentiles...
2 assuming, by the way, that you know God gave me the special responsibility of extending
His grace to you Gentiles. 3 As I briefly wrote earlier,

<u>God Himself revealed His mysterious plan</u> to me. 4 As you read what I have written, you will understand my insight into this plan regarding Christ.

Understanding the mystery...

✓ The "mystery" was kept secret a long time.

Ephesians 3:9 NLT

I was chosen to explain to everyone this mysterious plan that God, the Creator of all things, had **kept secret from the beginning**.

✓ The Holy Spirit <u>reveals</u> the "mystery".

Ephesians 3:5 NLT

God did not reveal it to previous generations,

but now by His Spirit He has revealed it to His holy apostles and prophets.

✓ The "mystery" is Good News to those who believe.

Ephesians 3:6 NLT

And this is God's plan: Both Gentiles and Jews

who believe the Good News share equally in the riches inherited by God's children...

 \checkmark An obstacle to the revelation of God's mysterious plan can be <u>us</u>.

Ephesians 3:8 Message

When it came to presenting the Message to people who had no background in God's way,

I was the least qualified of any of the available Christians.

God saw to it that I was equipped, but you can be sure that it had nothing to do with my natural abilities. And so here I am, preaching and writing about things that are way over my head, the inexhaustible riches and generosity of Christ.

- 3. DEVELOP your relationship with God.

Ephesians 3:14-19 NLT

14 When I think of all this, I fall to my knees and <u>pray to the Father</u>, 15 the Creator of everything in heaven and on earth. 16 I pray that from His glorious, <u>unlimited resources</u>

He will empower you with inner strength through His Spirit. 17 Then <u>Christ will make his home in your hearts</u> as you trust in Him. Your roots will grow down into God's love and keep you strong. 18 And may <u>you have the power to understand</u>,

as all God's people should, how wide, how long, how high, and how deep <u>His love</u> is.

19 May <u>you experience the love of Christ</u>, though it is too great to understand fully. Then <u>you will be made complete with all the fullness of life and power that comes from God.</u>

4. DEMONSTRATE the power of God.

Ephesians 3:20-21 NASU

20 Now to <u>Him who is able to do far more abundantly beyond all that we ask or think, according to the power that works within us</u>, 21 to Him be the glory in the church and in Christ Jesus to all generations forever and ever. Amen
