✓ You grow stronger with God's family.

1. Talk with the Family.

Matthew 12:46 NIV

Jesus was still talking to the crowd

Ephesians 2:14 TLB

For Christ Himself is our way of peace.

He has made peace between us Jews and you Gentiles by <u>making us all one family</u>, <u>breaking down the wall of contempt that used to separate us.</u>

2. Receive the Family.

Matthew 12:46 NIV

While Jesus was still talking to the crowd,

His mother and brothers stood outside, wanting to speak to Him.

Romans 15:7 NKJV

Therefore *receive one another, just as Christ also received us*, to the glory of God.

3. Be the Family.

Mark 3:34-35 NKJV

34 And He looked around in a circle at those who sat about Him, and said,

"Here are My mother and My brothers!

35 For whoever does the will of God is My brother and My sister and mother."

1 Peter 1:3 TLB
