Matthew 11:28-30 Message

28 "Are you tired? Worn out? Burned out on religion? Come to Me. Get away with Me and you'll recover your life. I'll show you how to take a real rest.

29 Walk with Me and work with Me — watch how I do it.

Learn the unforced rhythms of grace. I won't lay anything heavy or ill-fitting on you.

30 Keep company with Me and you'll learn to live freely and lightly."

1. Wants

Philippians 4:6-7 NLT

6 Don't worry about anything; instead, <u>pray</u> about everything.

<u>Tell God what you need</u>, and thank Him for all He has done.

7 Then you will experience God's peace, which exceeds anything we can understand. His peace will guard your hearts and minds as you live in Christ Jesus.

2. With

Proverbs 27:17 NLT

As iron sharpens iron, so a friend sharpens a friend.

3. Word

Romans 10:17 NKJV

So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.

4. Work

Colossians 3:23-24 NLT

23 Work willingly at whatever you do, <u>as though you were working for the Lord</u> rather than for people. 24 Remember that the Lord will give you an inheritance as your reward, and that the Master you are serving is Christ.

5. Withholdings

2 Corinthians 9:6-9 NIT

6 Remember this—a farmer who plants only a few seeds will get a small crop.

But the one who plants generously will get a generous crop. 7 You must each decide in your heart how much to give. And don't give reluctantly or in response to pressure. "For God loves a person who gives cheerfully." 8 And God will generously provide all you need. Then you will always have everything you need and plenty left over to share with others.
