## What hinders people from getting water baptized?

Acts 8:36 NKJV

"What <u>hinders</u> me from being baptized?"

- ✓ **Traditions**: Babies are incapable of repentance, faith & public testimonies
- ✓ Fear of man: We must acknowledge Jesus publicly.

Matthew 10:32 NLT

Everyone who acknowledges Me publicly here on earth,

I will also acknowledge before My Father in heaven.

✓ **Rejection of God's** plan for their life: "I will live out my faith my way."

Luke 7:30 NLT

But the Pharisees and experts in religious law <u>rejected God's plan for them</u>, for they had refused John's baptism.

✓ **Too** "Spiritual": "Don't need water baptism...Already baptized with Holy Spirit"

Acts 10:48 NIV

"Can anyone keep these people from <u>being baptized with water</u>?

They have received the Holy Spirit just as we have."

✓ Unwilling to <u>change</u> lifestyle: We must leave our old sinful lifestyle.

Romans 6:1-3 NLT

1 Well then, should we keep on sinning so that God can show us more and more of His wonderful grace? 2 Of course not! Since we have died to sin, how can we continue to live in it? 3 Or have you forgotten that when we were joined with Christ Jesus in baptism, we joined Him in His death?

# Do Christians Need To Be Water Baptized?

## Why should Christians be water baptized?

✓ It's an act of obedience.

Matthew 3:15 NLT

But Jesus said, "It should be done, for we must carry out all that God requires."

So John agreed to baptize Him.

✓ Symbolizes the  $\dfrac{\mathsf{death}}{\mathsf{death}}$  of your old life and start of your  $\dfrac{\mathsf{new}}{\mathsf{new}}$  life.

Romans 6:11 NLT

So you also should **consider yourselves to be <u>dead to the power of sin</u>** and **alive to God through Christ Jesus.** 

✓ It's your  $\frac{\text{public}}{\text{public}}$  declaration of your new identification.

Colossians 2:12 NLT

For you were buried <u>with Christ</u> when you were baptized. And <u>with Him</u> you were raised to new life because <u>you trusted the mighty power of God, who raised Christ from the dead</u>.

#### What must I do to be water baptized?

1. Repent – Turn from old life of sin and turn to God.

Acts 2:38 NIT

Peter replied, "Each of <u>you must repent of your sins, turn to God</u>, and <u>be baptized</u> in the name of Jesus Christ to <u>show that you have received forgiveness for your sins.</u>

Then you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.

2. **Believe** with all your heart Jesus is the Son of God.

Acts 8:37 NASB

And Philip said, "If you believe with all your heart, you may."

And he answered and said, "I believe that Jesus Christ is the Son of God."]

3. **Proclaim** Jesus Lord with your words and actions.

1 Corinthians 12:13 Message

By means of His one Spirit, we all said good-bye to our partial and piecemeal lives.

We each used to independently call our own shots, but then we entered into a large and integrated life in which <u>He has the final say in everything</u>.

(This is what we proclaimed in word and action when we were baptized.)
