Genesis 3:8-10 NASU

8 They heard the sound of the Lord God walking in the garden in the cool of the day, and the **man and his wife hid themselves from the presence of the Lord God** among the trees of the garden. 9 Then the Lord God called to the man, and said to him, "Where are you?" 10 He said, "I heard the sound of You in the garden, and **I was afraid because I was naked; so I hid myself.**"

Power of the Kingdom of Darkness

- ✓ **Fear:** Distressing emotion caused by the pain of sin.
- ✓ **Shame:** Stripped of royal clothing of righteousness.
- ✓ **Hidden Sin:** Keeps people from the presence of God.

Revelation 6:15-17 NIV

15 Then the kings of the earth, the princes, the generals, the rich, the mighty, and every slave and every free man hid in caves and among the rocks of the mountains. 16 They called to the mountains and the rocks, "**Fall on us and hide us from the face of Him who sits on the throne and from the wrath of the Lamb!**" 17 For the great day of their wrath has come, and who can stand?"

1. King Jesus gives you real **freedom**.

John 8:36 CEV

John 5:19-20 Message

19 So Jesus explained Himself at length.

"I'm telling you this straight. **The Son can't independently do a thing**, only what He sees the Father doing. What the Father does, the Son does. 20 The Father loves the Son and includes Him in everything He is doing.

Luke 10:19 NKJV

Luke 22:29 NIV

Do not fear, little flock, for it is your **Father's good pleasure to give you the kingdom**.

Daniel 7:27 NKJV

Then the kingdom and dominion, And the greatness of the kingdoms under the whole heaven, **Shall be given to the people, the saints of the Most High.** **His kingdom is an everlasting kingdom**, And all dominions shall serve and obey Him.
