Holy Ghost Portable Power...

1. You have been given power to be a witness.

Acts 1:8 ERV

But the Holy Spirit will come on you and give you power. You will be My witnesses.

You will tell people everywhere about Me—in Jerusalem, in the rest of Judea,
in Samaria, and in every part of the world.

✓ Be a character witness. Inside witness

Ephesians 4:23b-24 Message

23b...a life renewed from the inside 24 and working itself into your conduct as *God accurately reproduces His character in you*.

✓ Speak about Jesus with fearless confidence. Outside witness

Acts 4:29-31 Message

29 "And now they're at it again! Take care of their threats and *give your servants fearless confidence* in preaching your Message, 30 as you stretch out your hand to us in healings and miracles and wonders done in the name of your holy servant Jesus."
31 While they were praying, the place where they were meeting trembled and shook. They were all *filled with the Holy Spirit and continued to speak God's Word with fearless confidence*.

Mark 16:15-16 GOD'S WORD 15 Then Jesus said to them,

"So wherever you go in the world, <u>tell everyone the Good News.</u> 16 Whoever believes and is baptized will be saved, but whoever does not believe will be condemned.

Mark 16:19-20 NIV

✓ Live by the "5 - minute rule".

Luke 10:18-20 ERV

18 Jesus said to them, "I saw Satan falling like lightning from the sky. 19 He is the enemy, but know that <u>I have given you more power</u> than he has. <u>I have given you power</u> to crush his snakes and scorpions under your feet. Nothing will hurt you.

20 Yes, even the spirits obey you. And you can be happy,

not because you have this power, but because your names are written in heaven."
