#### Keep watch!

Mark 13:34-37 NLT

34 "The coming of the Son of Man can be illustrated by the story of a man going on a long trip. When he left home, he gave each of his slaves instructions about the work they were to do, and he told the gatekeeper to watch for his return. 35 You, too, must keep watch!

For you don't know when the master of the household will return—in the evening, at midnight, before dawn, or at daybreak. 36 Don't let him find you sleeping when he arrives without warning. 37 I say to you what I say to everyone: Watch for him!"

#### The dangers of God's people falling asleep.

✓ Samson was lulled to sleep and lost his strength.

Judges 16:19 NLT

<u>Delilah Iulled Samson to sleep</u> with his head in her lap, and then she called in a man to shave off the seven locks of his hair. In this way she began to bring him down, and <u>his strength left him.</u>

✓ Jonah slept through his calling.

Jonah 1:5-6 ERV

5...Jonah had gone down into the boat to lie down, and <u>he went to sleep</u>.
6 The captain of the boat saw Jonah and said, <u>"Wake up! Why are you sleeping?</u>
Pray to your god! <u>Maybe your god will hear your prayer and save us!"</u>

✓ Eutychus fell asleep in church...

Acts 20:9 NLT

As Paul spoke on and on, a young man named Eutychus, sitting on the windowsill, became very drowsy.

Finally, he fell sound asleep and dropped three stories to his death below.

✓ Foolish bridesmaids slept unfilled.

Matthew 25:3-5 NKJV

3 Those who were foolish took their lamps and <u>took no oil with them</u>, 4 but the wise took oil in their vessels with their lamps.

5 But while the bridegroom was delayed, they all slumbered and slept.

# 1. Awake from the things that Iull your senses!

1 Thessalonians 5:6-8 AMP

6 Accordingly then, <u>let us not sleep</u>, as the rest do, but let us keep wide awake

(alert, watchful, cautious, and on our guard)

and let us be sober (calm, collected, and circumspect).

7 For those who sleep, sleep at night, and those who are drunk, get drunk at night.

8 But we belong to the day; therefore, let us be sober and put on the breastplate (corslet) of faith and love and for a helmet the hope of salvation.

## 2. Alert to dangers.

1 Corinthians 16:13 AMP

#### Be alert and on your quard; stand firm in your faith

(your conviction respecting man's relationship to God and divine things, keeping the trust and holy fervor born of faith and a part of it).

Act like men and be courageous; grow in strength!

## 3. Activate your faith.

2 Peter 1:5-11 Message

5 So don't lose a minute in building on what you've been given, complementing your basic faith with good character, spiritual understanding, 6 alert discipline, passionate patience, reverent wonder, 7 warm friendliness, and generous love, each dimension fitting into and developing the others.

- 8 With these qualities active and growing in your lives, no grass will grow under your feet no day will pass without its reward as you mature in your experience of our Master Jesus.
  - 9 Without these qualities you can't see what's right before you, oblivious that your old sinful life has been wiped off the books.
- 10 So, friends, <u>confirm God's invitation to you, His choice of you. Don't put it off; do it now.</u>
  Do this, and you'll have your life on a firm footing, 11 the streets paved and the way wide open into the eternal kingdom of our Master and Savior, Jesus Christ.

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
