Warning For Then and Now

Luke 19:38-44 NASB

38 saying, "Blessed is the King who comes in the name of the Lord;
Peace in heaven and glory in the highest!" 39 And some of the Pharisees in the multitude said to Him, "Teacher, rebuke Your disciples." 40 And He answered and said,

"I tell you, if these become silent, the stones will cry out!"

41 And when He approached, He saw the city and wept over it, 42 saying, "If you had known in this day, even you, the things which make for peace! But now they have been hidden from your eyes. 43 "For the days shall come upon you when your enemies will throw up a bank before you, and surround you, and hem you in on every side, 44 and will level you to the ground and your children within you, and they will not leave in you one stone upon another, because you did not recognize the time of your visitation. "

How did the Pharisees miss the Lord's coming?

✓ Didn't recognize Jesus as Messiah.

Luke 19:38 NASB

... "Blessed is the King who comes in the name of the Lord...

✓ Didn't recognize the days of the Messiah.

Luke 19:42 NASB

"If you had known in this day, even you...But now they have been hidden from your eyes.

✓ Didn't recognize the warning of <u>judgment</u> from Messiah.

Luke 19:44 NASB

...will not leave in you one stone upon another...

The Prophetic Word for Then and Now

Daniel 9:24-27 NASB

24 "Seventy weeks have been decreed for your people and your holy city, to finish the transgression, to make an end of sin, to make atonement for iniquity, to bring in everlasting righteousness, to seal up vision and prophecy, and to anoint the most holy place. 25 "So you are to know and discern that from the issuing of a decree to restore and rebuild Jerusalem until Messiah the Prince there will be seven weeks and sixty-two weeks; it will be built again, with plaza and moat, even in times of distress. 26 "Then after the sixty-two weeks the Messiah will be cut off and have nothing, and the people of the prince who is to come will destroy the city and the sanctuary. And its end will come with a flood; even to the end there will be war; desolations are determined.

When The Stones Cry Out!

How not to miss the Lord's Coming...

1. Recognize the times.

Daniel 9:24-25 NASB

24 "<u>Seventy weeks</u> have been decreed for your people and your holy city...
25 So <u>you are to know and discern that from the issuing of a decree</u> to restore and rebuild

2. Recognize the decrees to rebuild.

Daniel 9:25 NASB

...Prince there will be seven weeks and sixty-two weeks; it will be built again, with plaza and moat, even in times of distress.

Isaiah 60:10a иклу

"The <u>sons of foreigners shall build up your walls</u>,
And their kings shall minister to you...

3. Recognize the **judgment** to come.

Daniel 9:26 NASB

"Then after <u>the sixty-two weeks the Messiah will be cut off</u> and have nothing, and <u>the people of the prince who is to come will destroy the city and the sanctuary.</u>

And its end will come with a flood; <u>even to the end there will be war;</u>

desolations are determined.

4. Recognize <mark>Jesus</mark> as your Messiah.

Notes:

Acts 2:36 AMP

Therefore let the whole house of Israel <u>recognize beyond all doubt</u> and acknowledge assuredly that <u>God has made Him both Lord and Christ (the Messiah)</u> — <u>this Jesus Whom you crucified.</u>
