1. You're **not** alone!

Romans 11:3 NLT

"Lord, they have killed your prophets and torn down your altars. I am the only one left, and now they are trying to kill me, too." 4 And do you remember God's reply?

He said, **"No, I have 7,000 others who have never bowed down to Baal!"**

2. Keep **praying!**

James 5:16-18 NKJV

16... **The effective, fervent prayer of a righteous man avails much.**

17 Elijah was a man with a nature like ours, and he prayed earnestly that it would not rain; and it did not rain on the land for three years and six months. 18 And he prayed again, and the heaven gave rain, and the earth produced its fruit.

3. **Repair** the altars the enemy has torn down.

1 Kings 18:30 NLT

Then Elijah called to the people, "Come over here!" They all crowded around him as he repaired the altar of the Lord that had been torn down.

4. **Proclaim** life over the children.

1 Kings 17:21-22 NKJV

21 And he stretched himself out on the child three times, and cried out to the Lord and said, "**O Lord my God, I pray, let this child's soul come back to him.**" 22 Then the Lord heard the voice of Elijah; and the soul of the child came back to him, and he revived.

5. **Anoint** the next generation for the mission!

1 Kings 19:15-16 NLT

15 Then the Lord told him, "Go back the same way you came, and travel to the wilderness of Damascus. When you arrive there, anoint Hazael to be king of Aram.

16 Then anoint Jehu son of Nimshi to be king of Israel, and anoint Elisha son of Shaphat from the town of Abel-meholah to replace you as My prophet.
