Last Days Getting Colder

How to warm things up...

1. **Respect** others as people made by God.

Psalms 139:13-15 NIV

13 **You created the deepest parts of my being.**

You put me together inside my mother's body. 14 How **You made me** is amazing and wonderful. I praise You for that. What You have done is wonderful. I know that very well. 15 None of my bones was hidden from You when **You made me inside my mother's body.**

2. **Reach** everyone with the Good News in love.

1 Thessalonians 5:14-15 CEV

14 My friends, we beg you to **warn anyone who isn't living right.**

Encourage anyone who feels left out, **help all who are weak**, and be **patient with everyone**. 15 Don't be hateful to people, just because they are hateful to you.

Rather, **be good to each other and to everyone else.**

- ✓ **Warn** people of the cost of sin.
- ✓ **Encourage** anyone who feels left out and scared.
- ✓ **Help** the weak.
- ✓ Display **patience** with everyone.
- ✓ Demonstrate **goodness** even to those who hate.

3. **Re-evaluate** what is most important.

Mark 8:36-37 NLT

36 And what do you benefit if you gain the whole world but lose your own soul?

37 **Is anything worth more than your soul?**
