Next To Jesus

1. Let people know what you're <u>for</u>...

instead of what you're against.

Luke 13:14 NLT

14 But the leader in charge of the synagogue was indignant that Jesus had healed her on the Sabbath day. "There are six days of the week for working," he said to the crowd.

"Come on those days to be healed, not on the Sabbath."

Luke 6:9 NLT

Then Jesus said to his critics, "I have a question for you. *Does the law permit good deeds* <u>on the Sabbath</u>, or is it a day for doing evil? Is this a day to save life or to destroy it?"

2. Don't remain silent when given the opportunity to repent.

Luke 14:3-6 NIV

3 Jesus asked the Pharisees and experts in the law, "Is it lawful to heal on the Sabbath or not?" 4 <u>But they remained silent</u>. So taking hold of the man, he healed him and sent him away. 5 Then he asked them, "If one of you has a son or an ox that falls into a well on the Sabbath day, will you not immediately pull him out?" 6 And <u>they had nothing to say</u>.

3. Set the table for those outside your inner circle.

Luke 14:12-13 NLT

12 Then he turned to his host. "When you put on a luncheon or a banquet," he said, "don't invite your friends, brothers, relatives, and rich neighbors. For they will invite you back, and that will be your only reward.

13 Instead, *invite the poor, the crippled, the lame, and the blind.*

4. Be ready by not excusing yourself from the mission.

Luke 14:16-18 NLT

16 Jesus replied with this story: "A man prepared a great feast and sent out many invitations. 17 When the banquet was ready, <u>he sent his servant to tell the guests</u>, 'Come, the banquet is ready.' 18 But <u>they all began making excuses</u>.
