#### Why don't people talk about the Rapture?

✓ Set Times emphasized over  $\frac{Certainty}{}$ .

1 Thessalonians 5:1-2 NLT

Now concerning how and when all this will happen, dear brothers and sisters, we don't really need to write you. 2 For you know quite well that the day of the Lord's return will come unexpectedly, like a thief in the night.

✓ Wrath emphasized over Rescue.

1 Thessalonians 5:9 NKJV

For God did not appoint us to wrath, but to obtain salvation through our Lord Jesus Christ

**Noah <u>rescued</u> from the flood** (Matt 24:37-41 parties, banquets & weddings- life as usual) **Lot rescued from the fire & brimstone** (Luke 17:28-30 business as usual)

## ✓ Delay emphasized over Discipleship.

Luke 12:45-46 Message

45 But if he says to himself, <u>'The master is certainly taking his time</u>,' begins maltreating the servants and maids, throws parties for his friends, and gets drunk, 46 the master will walk in when he least expects it...

✓ Comfort emphasized over Christ.

Luke 17:31-34 NASB

- 31 On that day, let not the one who is on the housetop and whose goods are in the house go down to take them away; and likewise let not the one who is in the field turn back.

  32 "Remember Lot's wife.
- 33 Whoever seeks to keep his life shall lose it, and whoever loses his life shall preserve it.
