✓ <u>Self</u>-Absorbed

2 Timothy 3:1-2 NASB 1 But realize this, that in the last days <u>difficult times will come</u>. 2 For <u>men will be lovers of self</u>...

✓ Not knowing God's Word.

Matthew 1:22-23 NLT

22 All of this occurred to fulfill the Lord's message through His prophet:

23 "Look! The virgin will conceive a child! She will give birth to a Son, and they will call Him Immanuel, which means 'God is with us.'"

\checkmark The need to <u>understand</u> everything completely.

Proverbs 3:5-6 NKJV

1. Care for others like Jesus cares.

Matthew 1:19 NLT

Joseph, her fiancé, was a good man and did not want to disgrace her publicly,

so he decided to break the engagement quietly.

Psalm 115:4-8 NLT

4 Their idols are merely things of silver and gold, shaped by human hands.
5 They have mouths but cannot speak, and eyes but cannot see.
6 They have ears but cannot hear, and noses but cannot smell.
7 They have hands but cannot feel,
and feet but cannot walk, and throats but cannot make a sound.

8 And those who make idols are just like them, as are all who trust in them.

Philippians 2:3-5 CEV

3 Don't be jealous or proud, but be humble and consider others more important than yourselves. 4 <u>Care about them as much as you care about yourselves</u> 5 and <u>think the same way that Christ Jesus thought</u>:

Matthew 1:20-21 NLT

Matthew 1:24-25 NLT

24 When Joseph woke up, <u>he did as the angel of the Lord commanded</u> and took Mary as his wife. 25 But <u>he did not have sexual relations with her</u> until her son was born. <u>And Joseph named Him Jesus.</u>

John 14:15 CEV

Jesus said to His disciples: If you love Me, you will do as I command.
