## Welcome to **2021 Breakthrough**

**2021 Breakthrough** is twenty-one days of praying, fasting and listening to God for His wisdom in applying His Word to your life in the year 2021 A.D.



The Lord Jesus wants us to write down the plans He has for us.

*2 Samuel 5:20 NKJV*

*So David went to Baal Perazim, and David defeated them there; and he said, "The Lord has **broken through** my enemies before me, like a **breakthrough** of water."*

### **2021 Breakthrough**

will help you to see the vision the Lord has for your life and in the lives of others.

The LORD wants to make things work out for you, though it may seem difficult at times, His **2021 Breakthrough** for you will come at the right time.

To understand what God's plans are for your life in the coming year, we have learned that reading the Bible along with worship, prayer and fasting are the best ways to hear from God.

We will set aside some of the first days of the new year to hear, see and write down the breakthroughs that the Lord has for us in 2021 A.D. to make the most of this new year.

The evenings of the 21 days are dedicated to corporate worship and prayer. Our meals of the 21 days are impacted by a fast that everyone will have to choose to make a way to humble the soul to hear from God.

Daniel prayed and fasted for 21 days and then God sent an angel to him who said...

*Daniel 10:14 NASU*

*"Now I have come to give you an **understanding** of what will happen..."*



It is a blessing to experience what God can do in your life. Both prayer and fasting have promises of **rewards** from the Father when done with the right motives.

*Matthew 6:6 NASU*

*"But you, when you **pray**, go into your inner room, close your door and **pray** to your Father who is in secret, and your Father who sees what is done in secret will **reward** you.*

*Matthew 6:17-18 NASU*

*"But you, when you **fast**, anoint your head and wash your face so that your **fasting** will not be noticed by men, but by your Father who is in secret; and your Father who sees what is done in secret will **reward** you.*

In the 21 days of **2021 Breakthrough**, my hope for you to know with clarity the vision the Lord has for you and that you would hear from the LORD throughout all of your prayers, fasting and that His plans and purpose for you would be made known so you can set your priorities in order for 2021 A.D.

## Developing Your Own Plan

The following page of your Journal includes suggestions for developing your own plan for seeking the Lord's Will for this year.

# 2021 Breakthrough each day

## 1. Worship

We will follow the instructions from the Word of God in...

Psalms 100:4 NASU

*Enter His gates with thanksgiving and His courts with praise.*

### **a. Thanksgiving**

For each day, a specific scripture is provided in your journal dealing with Thanking God to encourage you to reflect on God's past blessings and give thanks.

### **b. Praise**

Also, a specific scripture is given dealing with Praising God. This is to encourage you to think about God's greatness and to honor Him by expressing your appreciation of who He is.

## 2. Reading the Bible

Each day your Journal will feature a special collection of scriptures for your consideration.

Reading the Word of God builds our faith to receive the answers to prayer.

Many of us will also follow the reading plan in the One Year Bible. Others will use a different plan.

## 3. Prayer

Each day you will place before God...

1. A request that He reveal His will for you...
2. A "Daily Corporate Prayer Request" and...
3. Requests from your own Personal Prayer List.

You can begin now to list your prayer requests on the pages that are labeled Personal Prayer List.

## 4. Journaling

There is also a place (My Prayer Journal) for you to write your...

1. Own thoughts on that day.
2. Requests, prayers and petitions you are making.
3. Guidance and impressions that God provides.
4. Answers you receive to your prayers.

## Continuing Reflection

Finally, the last three pages of the Journal (Day 22-29 of Reflecting) are for use during the 21 Days and the week following. You may make entries on these pages at any time during the 21 Days.

### **1. What Did I Hear From God and What Will I Do About It?**

As you continue to listen to God you can write down your impressions that came during the 21 days. Record the important things you should do because of what you have heard.

### **2. My New Prayer List for 2021 A.D.** This could be your best prayer list ever.



## Your 2021 Breakthrough Plan

### How will I make Worship a part of each day?

Your Journal includes Scriptures of thanksgiving and praise which you can **read aloud**.

Many of us will **listen** to Christian music and possibly **sing along** in worship at various times during the day. Each evening when we gather, we will enjoy lifting our voices together in worship.

### How will I keep a regular schedule of Reading God's Word?

There are a number of Bible verses listed in the **Journal** for each day. These verses relate to the subjects that will be emphasized in prayer on that specific day. It will be of great value to read and meditate on those scriptures. In addition, many people have a regular plan of reading the Word.

For example:

- a. Read the One Year Bible,
- b. Read the New Testament portion of the One Year Bible,
- c. Read just the Psalms and Proverbs readings in the One Year Bible,
- d. Read a chapter from a book of the Bible daily or
- e. Any other Bible reading plan of your choosing.

### How will I set aside my time for Personal Prayer?

For example:

- a. Pray first thing in the morning (5 minutes, 1 hour, etc.)
- b. Attend the prayer meetings each day at the church
- c. Pray during a meal that I skip, etc.
- d. Do all of the above.

### How will I carry out my Personal Fasting?

(Fasting is abstaining from food or abstaining from a certain kind of food.)

For example:

- a. Do the Daniel fast, no meat, only vegetables.
- b. Do a modified Daniel fast, no meat, only non-meat foods, no caffeine, no sweets, etc.
- c. Do a no carb, no sugar, no caffeine type of fast.
- d. Skip one meal per day.
- e. Skip two meals per day.
- f. Don't eat out at restaurants, drive thru or carry outs.
- g. Some combination of methods of fasting.

The important thing is to have a plan and stick with it.

## **The LORD'S Prayer Pattern**

Many Christians recite the Lord's Prayer word for word almost without much thought or passion, but there's so much more to this prayer. The Lord Jesus provided this model as an outline to teach us how to pray in a way that connects us to God the Father, aligns our priorities with His, and helps us live dependently on Him and follow Him through obedience and example. This model takes us through each part of The Lord's Prayer, showing us how to pray the way the Lord Jesus instructed.

Matthew 6:9-13 NKJV

9 **In this manner, therefore, pray:**

***Our Father in heaven,***

### **CONNECT WITH GOD RELATIONALLY:**

*God doesn't want religion...He desires a relationship with us.*

*God has adopted us as His children and loves for us to call Him our Father.*

*Let's start our prayer time acknowledging our relationship with God as our Father in heaven.*

*Proclaim your intimate relationship with God every day by addressing Him lovingly as your Father and thanking Him that you are His child.*

***Hallowed be Your name.***

### **WORSHIP HIS NAME:**

God loves when we worship Him and there is power in His Name.

Here is a list of some of His Names to help us worship Him specifically and personally:

***Jehovah – Tsidkenu: The LORD is our Righteousness! “He forgives all our iniquities”***

*\*God is our righteousness who placed our iniquities in Christ.*

***Jehovah – Rapha: The LORD is our Healer! “He heals all of our diseases”***

*\*God is our physician who places our diseases on Christ.*

***Jehovah – Nissi: The LORD is our Victory! “He redeems our life from destruction”***

*\*God is our Protector who defeated all the forces of darkness in Christ.*

***Jehovah – Shammah: The LORD is our Presence! “He crowns us with lovingkindness”***

*\*God is our Presence who sent us the Holy Spirit in Christ.*

***Jehovah – Jireh: The LORD is our Provider! “He satisfies us with good things”***

*\*God is our Provider who supplied all our needs in Christ.*

***Jehovah – Rohi: The LORD is our Shepherd! “He tends and cares for us”***

*\*God cares for us and leads us to still waters and green pastures.*

***Speak God's Names out loud.***

*When we proclaim who He is, we worship Him and reminds ourselves how powerful and great our God is. Speaking out loud the Names of God also makes the enemy tremble with fear.*

## **10 Your kingdom come. Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven.**

### **MAKE HIS KINGDOM AND RIGHTEOUSNESS THE PRIORITY:**

*His Kingdom is the fruit of the Spirit.*

*God's divine character in control of our thoughts, words, and actions.*

*God's will is perfect, and we acknowledge His wisdom and sovereignty when we pray His agenda first.*

*God will always give us all we need from day to day if we will make His Kingdom our priority.*

*God's priorities include: \*Saving the lost \*Wisdom and guidance for those in authority— parental, spiritual, governmental, work-related \* Caring for the poor, marginalized and unborn \* Unity and love \*Justice \*Freedom for those in bondage \*Accomplishing His purpose in our lives.*

## **11 Give us this day our daily bread.**

### **DEPEND ON HIM FOR EVERYTHING:**

*God wants us to let our needs be known to Him.*

*God promises to supply all our needs.*

*God wants us to come to Him with our problems, needs, and desires and to trust Him to provide.*

## **12 And forgive us our debts, As we forgive our debtors.**

### **FORGIVE AND BE FORGIVEN:**

*God has offered us complete forgiveness whenever we confess and ask...through Christ Jesus.*

*The LORD is faithful and just to forgive us every time we confess our sins to HIM.*

*We are strengthened to forgive others when we turn away from our sins and receive His forgiveness.*

*God wants us to pray for others, including those who challenge healthy relationships and even enemies.*

*God wants us to "stand in the gap" before HIM for mercy of our families, friends, city, state, and nation.*

## **13 And do not lead us into temptation, But deliver us from the evil one.**

### **ENGAGE IN SPIRITUAL WARFARE:**

*God wants us to fight against the powers of darkness.*

*The Lord said that our enemy came to steal, kill and destroy us, but JESUS came to give us abundant life.*

*God wants you to take authority in resisting demonic attack in your health, finances, family, ministry & nation.*

*God empowers us with the Holy Spirit to pray, stand firm in the faith and fight against the enemy.*

*God has already given us the victory through Jesus.*

*There is power in God's Word, and with HIS Truth we can defeat every lie the enemy has told us.*

*Through prayer, we can resist the enemy and continue to walk forward in freedom.*

*Our prayers along with the BLOOD of JESUS...the WORD of GOD...our Testimony proclaims our victory!*

## **For Yours is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever. Amen.**

### **PROCLAIM GOD IS ALMIGHTY FOREVERMORE:**

*God is more than able to move in every situation and for all time.*

*His authority and power focuses our minds on the truth and hope of who He is and what He can do.*

*Nothing is too hard for the LORD GOD ALMIGHTY!*

*All authority...All power...All glory...All praises belong to the LORD for All time!*





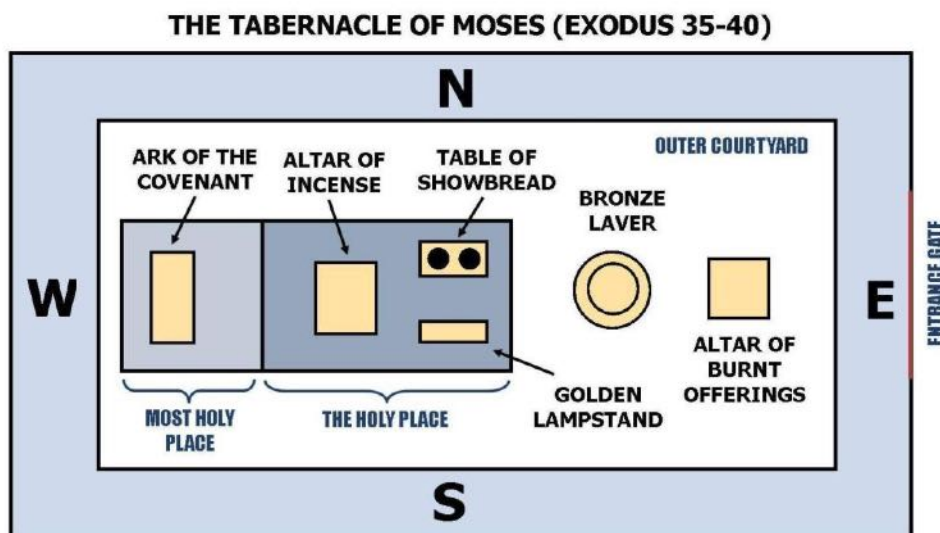
## *The Tabernacle Prayer Pattern*

**1. The Gate of Thanksgiving:** Enter the Tabernacle by applying this Scripture...

Psalm 100:4 NIV

Enter His gates with ***thanksgiving*** and His courts with ***praise***;  
give thanks to Him and praise His name.

- 2. The Brazen Altar:** This was the first item in the outer court. It was for the shedding of blood. This represents our gratitude for the scourging, the crown of thorns, the crucifixion, the burial, and the resurrection of our Lord Jesus.
- 3. The Laver:** The second item in the outer court. It represents our sanctification (separation from sin) of our body, mind, and spirit every day.
- 4. The Lampstand:** Represents the light from the seven attributes of the Holy Spirit: freedom, wisdom, understanding, counsel, might, knowledge, and fear of the Lord.
- 5. The Table of Showbread:** A fresh daily Word from the Scriptures (logos word) and from the Holy Spirit (rhema word).
- 6. The Incense Altar:** Elevate your worship in a way to rise like incense by singing and praying in the Spirit.
- 7. The Ark of the Covenant:** Enter the Holy of Holies to intercede before the Mercy Seat of God for your family, church, nation and for the “lost” to be saved throughout the world.





## ***The Trinity Prayer Pattern***

2 Corinthians 13:14 NKJV

The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, and the love of God,  
and the communion of the Holy Spirit be with you all. Amen.

### ***The Grace of our Lord Jesus Christ***

Jesus is God's grace manifested in the flesh. He left the glories of heaven to come down and live in the body the Holy Spirit prepared for Him in Mary's womb.

John 1:16 NIV

From the fullness of ***His grace*** we have all received one blessing after another.

### ***The Love of God the Father***

The word "love" in Hebrew is "hesed". One of the most emphasized phrases in the Old Testament is "His love endures forever".

1 Chronicles 16:34 NIV

Give thanks to the Lord, for He is good; ***His love endures forever.***

God's "hesed" love is a covenant love. It is a love that is so far above a regular love that it can only come from a superior to an inferior. It is a love that is full of mercy, strong and loyal. It is used to describe God's love repeatedly in the Psalms. Many verses use the word "hesed" with the word "emet" which means faithfulness.

Exodus 34:5-7 NIV

5 Then the Lord came down in the cloud and stood there with him and proclaimed His name, the Lord. 6 And He passed in front of Moses, proclaiming, "The Lord, the Lord, the compassionate and gracious God, slow to anger, abounding in ***love*** (hesed) and ***faithfulness*** (emet), 7 maintaining love to thousands, and forgiving wickedness, rebellion and sin. Yet He does not leave the guilty unpunished; He punishes the children and their children for the sin of the fathers to the third and fourth generation."

Thank and praise God for His immense "hesed" love for you and receive its fullness.

### ***The Fellowship of the Holy Spirit***

After receiving the grace of the Lord Jesus Christ and the love of God the Father, invite the Holy Spirit for more times of intimate fellowship. Surrender every part of yourself to God...your eyes, ears, hands, feet, mouth, mind and heart to experience the fullness of the freedom of the Holy Spirit.

2 Corinthians 3:17 NIV

Now the Lord is the Spirit, and ***where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is freedom.***

Invite the Holy Spirit to an intimate fellowship that will produce fruit in all seasons of your life.

Galatians 5:22-23 NIV

22 But the ***fruit of the Spirit*** is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, 23 gentleness and self-control.





# DAY 1

## Friday, January 1

**Note: Meet in the sanctuary each night from 7:00 pm to 8:00 p.m.**

**Worship:** Follow your own plan to make worship a part of every day.

### Thanking God

Luke 10:21 NLT

At that same time Jesus was filled with the joy of the Holy Spirit, and He said,  
"O Father, Lord of heaven and earth, thank you for hiding these things from those who think themselves wise and clever, and for revealing them to the childlike. Yes, Father, it pleased you to do it this way."

**Prayer: Thank God for something you are grateful for.**

### Praising God

Exodus 15:2 NASU

"The LORD is my strength and song, and He has become my salvation;  
This is my God, and I will praise Him"

**Prayer: Compliment God for something that is good about Him.**

### Reading of Scripture: *Seek a Revelation from God through Prayer and Fasting*

In addition to your own reading plan read Daniel 9:1-26 and Matthew 6:5-6, 16-18. (*Revelation/Reward for prayer and fasting.*) Read 2 Peter 3:9 (*Revelation of Repentance...God wants everyone to be saved.*)

### Prayer

#### 1. *Pray every day for your 2021 Breakthrough:*

- a. Give me a revelation of Your will for me. Reveal Your purpose and plans for me.
- b. What should be my goals and priorities for 2021 A.D.
- c. What disciplines and habits must I implement in my life to accomplish these goals and priorities.
- d. Help me to hear Your voice as I meditate on Your Word and Pray.

#### 2. *Pray for the Salvation of the Lost:*

- a. Pray that your **loved ones** (name them) would become part of the eternal family of God.
- b. Pray for **boldness to speak** the Word of God about salvation to people you know and meet.
- c. Pray for those who are still **ignorant** of God's plan for them, or who have **rejected** His plan... would receive someone speaking the truth to them and that they would believe.
- d. Pray that Muslims, Jehovah Witnesses, and people of other religions would come to know the truth and be **set free** to worship the one true God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ.

#### 3. *Pray for something on your own Personal Prayer List.*

I will tell of the loving-kindnesses of God. I will praise Him for all He has done; I will rejoice in His great goodness to Israel, which He has granted in accordance with His mercy and love.

**Prayer: Compliment God for something that is good about Him.**

**Reading of Scripture:** *Know God better and help others do the same.*

In addition to your own reading plan read Matthew 7:21-23 NIV, 1 John 2:4 ERV, Colossians 1:10 NLT Ephesians 1:17-18 NIV & The Message, Romans 6:4, Colossians 2;12 NLT, Matthew 3:11, Acts 1:8

### **Prayer**

#### **1. *Pray every day for your 2021 Breakthrough:***

- a. Give me a revelation of Your will for me. Reveal Your purpose and plans for me.
- b. What should be my goals and priorities for 2021 A.D.
- c. What disciplines and habits must I implement in my life to accomplish these goals and priorities.
- d. Help me to hear Your voice as I meditate on Your Word and Pray.

#### **2. *Pray that you would know God better:***

- a. Pray especially that your **relationship with God** would improve (*no matter how good it is*).
- b. Pray that God would increase your wisdom and revelation about Him through His Spirit.
- c. Pray for more understanding and discernment in knowing God personally.
- d. Pray for Christians to publicly proclaim they belong to Jesus through water baptism.
- e. Pray that every follower of Christ would grasp the extent of this glorious way of life.
- f. Pray for every believer to receive the Baptism of the Holy Spirit.
- g. Pray that the eyes of your heart may be clear and focused to see what He has called you to do.

- b. What should be my goals and priorities for 2021 A.D.
- c. What disciplines and habits must I implement in my life to accomplish these goals and priorities.
- d. Help me to hear Your voice as I meditate on Your Word and Pray.

#### **2. Pray for Spiritual Guidance and Breakthroughs while you pray, fast, worship and read the Bible.**

- a. Pray that you **encounter the living God** and are **led** by the Holy Spirit into God's will.
- b. Pray that you will have the **faith and confidence** to walk in the direction that God is leading.
- c. Pray for visions and dreams from God that inspire you to look forward to the future.
- d. Pray that others you know would experience being set free and being led by the Holy Spirit.
- e. Pray that whenever we assemble... Sunday Worship Experience, Life Groups, Encounter Retreats, Prayer Meetings...that we will encounter the presence of God.
- f. Pray we would know the power of God's spoken Word, God's written Word and God the WORD.

- a. Give me a revelation of Your will for me. Reveal Your purpose and plans for me.
- b. What should be my goals and priorities for 2021 A.D.
- c. What disciplines and habits must I implement in my life to accomplish these goals and priorities.
- d. Help me to hear Your voice as I meditate on Your Word and Pray.

#### **2. Pray for Strong Family Relationships:**

- a. Pray that Jesus Christ would be the center of each family.
- b. Pray that husbands would love their wives as Christ loves the Church.
- c. Pray that wives would respect their husbands.
- d. Pray that parents would love their children, raise them with the proper respect for the Lord and with loving discipline.
- e. Pray that children would be raised in homes with both a father and a mother.
- f. Pray that children of divorced parents would experience healing and the love of the Lord.
- g. Pray that grandparents would influence and enjoy their grandchildren but be spared the responsibility of raising them.
- h. Pray that your relationships will be healthy, especially in your family, including your church family.

In addition to your own reading plan read 2 Chronicles 7:14, Matt. 6:9-15, Eph. 4:32, Col. 3:12-14.

### Prayer

#### **1. Pray every day for your 2021 Breakthrough:**

- a. Give me a revelation of Your will for me. Reveal Your purpose and plans for me.
- b. What should be my goals and priorities for 2021 A.D.
- c. What disciplines and habits must I implement in my life to accomplish these goals and priorities.
- d. Help me to hear Your voice as I meditate on Your Word and Pray.

#### **2. Receiving Forgiveness:**

- a. Ask the Holy Spirit to search your heart and reveal any unrighteousness.
- b. Pray for the forgiveness of any trespasses, debts, and sins.
- c. Pray that the Holy Spirit exposes sin and that He gives us a conviction that leads to repentance.
- d. Pray that other people encounter God's forgiveness through the presence of the Holy Spirit.
- e. Pray that people confess, repent, renounce their sins and receive forgiveness.

#### **3. Giving Forgiveness:**

- a. Declare to God your forgiveness of those who have wronged or hurt you. (*keep names private*)
- b. Pray for people to forgive those who have wronged or hurt them and that they receive great liberty as they forgive others.
